Design plastic waste collection schemes suitable for urban and rural environment

Organize training sessions for public authorities on plastic waste separation, collection and classification

Form network of communities and CSOs to focus on raising consumers´ awareness of plastic waste separation and collection

Organize activities at kindergartens, primary and high schools, universities, state and public institutions to raise awareness on waste collection and sorting

Propose innovations and investments after identifying the technology gaps of the plastic recycling companies

Organize seminar to introduce the technology innovations to the companies, explaining their economic feasibility

Conduct analysis of constraints regarding access to finance faced by plastic recycling companies

Based on the analysis, facilitate interactions between plastic recycling companies and finance service providers (banks, development funds, etc.)

Organize on-the-job training sessions abroad for key workers of plastic recycling companies

Identify and design new waste-based products from recycled plastic waste

Cooperate with soum and aimag authorities to facilitate the trial plastic waste recycling solutions for rural areas PLASTIC RECYCLING COMPANIES

Build marketing capacities of plastic recycling MSMEs

Develop health, safety and quality standards for products made of recycled plastic

Organize seminars, workshops and exhibitions to promote recycled products

Organize study tour abroad for recycling companies to familiarize them with promotion and marketing of recycled products PROJECT OUTCOME IS EASILY REPLICATED IN OTHER SOUMS AND PROVINCE

Organize events to involve decision-makers in follow-up activities aimed at replication and scale-up of results achieved by the project

Establish a cluster of local and international waste management experts who will participate in further replication actions

Develop and disseminate replication packages containing findings, recommendations, solutions and best practices produced by the project
